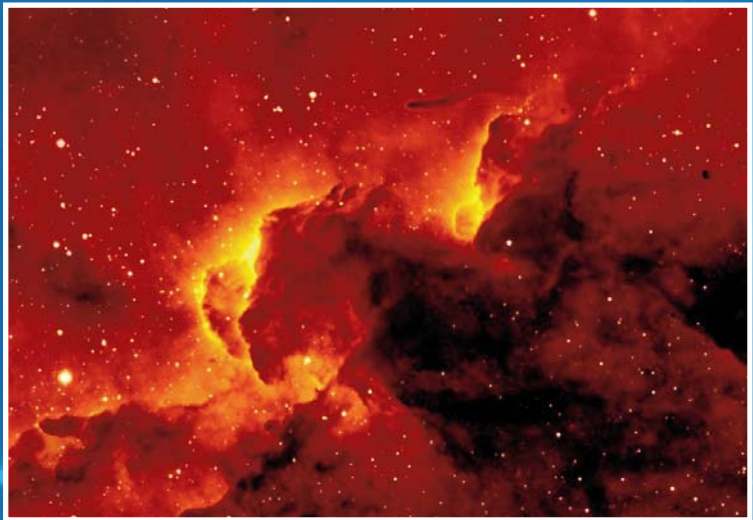

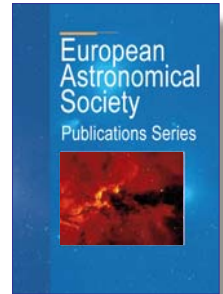

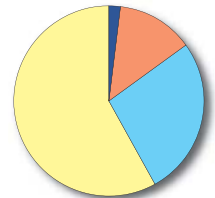
Invitation to publish

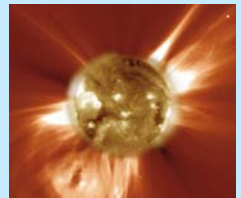
